

Terms & Conditions for attending a 'Temporary Campsite'

This Temporary Campsite (Rally) requires pre booking and pre payment

1. If you have been in contact with anyone recently with Coronavirus or if you have any symptoms of Covid-19 please do not attend.
2. On arrival at site, please wait in your vehicle for the host to direct you. Each person in your vehicle must be asked, in turn, to confirm that they do not have any COVID 19 symptoms. Should any person in a party declare, or exhibit, COVID 19 symptoms the whole camping party will not be permitted to enter the campsite.
3. All persons attending will be responsible for bringing their own Hand Sanitiser, cleaning materials and P.P.E.
4. All units will be sited so habitation doors are not facing, but still ensuring they can drive forward in an emergency. Groups will be spaced out around the site.
5. There will be no day visitors or non-members allowed onto the site.
6. No enclosed awnings/gazebos/tents to be erected which could be used for common shelters or social activities. Personal awnings/gazebos as part of a family's own outfit are permitted for family use only.
7. There shall be no sharing of food or drink, crockery or utensils to minimise transmission of infection.
8. There are to be no communal barbeques, again to minimise transmission of infection.
9. Covid-19 rules allow you to meet up to a maximum of 6 people from different households in an outdoor location, but still complying with social distancing rules.
10. Covid-19 rules allow 2 households (including anyone in your support bubble) to meet in a public or private location, indoors or outdoors, but still maintaining social distancing.
11. Please wash your hands on a regular basis and ensure you comply with the social distancing rules.
12. If anyone attending the meet becomes ill and has coronavirus symptoms, they must leave the site immediately and return home, self-isolate and seek appropriate medical guidance to arrange a covid-19 test as required by law. The commonly used areas such as rubbish bins, water taps, elsan, etc., must be closed and deep cleaned. Details of the incident must be recorded and kept.
13. Anyone attending this meet and not complying with these rules and thereby putting other persons at risk and or breaking social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the venue.

Please be aware that **this is an official MCC Temporary Campsite (rally)** in addition to the above, our normal rally rules (see below) will also apply.

If you are unsure or have any questions regarding these rules, please contact a member of the Committee **before** you attend the meet.

The Club has a legal responsibility to protect our members from infection by ensuring these controls are in place and implemented in accordance with the law.

A reminder of our normal rally rules:

1. Do not arrive before the advertised time, the club's insurance only starts from this time. Check the Group News Diary, Website or Facebook for any amendments.
2. Upon arrival book in with the hosts, membership cards must be shown.
3. Units shall be sited in accordance with the host's/committee's instructions, to leave a minimum distance of 6mts between facing sides of units and a roadway of at least 6mts between the rows of vans that is to be kept clear at all times for access of emergency vehicles. At least 3 mts between back to back units. There must be a clear passageway of 3mts between adjacent awnings when extended and the gap must not be blocked by windbreaks.
4. All units must be sited to ensure there are no facing doors and where possible should be sited to ensure they can drive forward when leaving the site.
5. Rallies are planned such that venues with limited capacity are made bookable.
6. However, if a rally reaches maximum capacity due to exceptional circumstances then this rally will be closed by order of the Committee.
7. If you would like to guarantee parking together with friends then please arrive together as we cannot save spaces.
8. Chemical toilets only to be emptied at the designated point and not taken to be cleaned at any drinking water point. This also applies to any container used for cleaning or filling the chemical toilet.
9. Member's and visitor's cars are only to be parked in the designated area.
10. Visitors to site must first register with the hosts.
11. A 5MPH speed limit on rally fields is to be observed.
12. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Any mess must be picked up.
13. Generators are allowed but only between the hours of 10am to 1pm and 3pm until 6pm. Longer periods will be considered if needed for medical reasons.
14. The safety and behaviour of children on site is the sole responsibility of their parents or guardians.
15. In case of emergency sound horn put hazard lights on ring club mobile 07804 506688.
16. Fire extinguishers will be available at the host's van.
17. Abusive or threatening behaviour towards hosts, committee members or members will not be tolerated. Any person being abusive will be asked to leave the rally.
18. All members attend rallies completely at their own risk. The organisers, hosts and committee accept no responsibility for persons or property brought onto the rally field.
19. If you have any concerns over health and safety please feel free to speak to the Safety Officer, any committee member or the hosts.
